We have owned this particular plant for many years. It was bought from David Littman when he was still alive. It's a good grower and I have sold off a couple of pieces. We grow this plant on the bench in a bushhouse covered in 70% shade on the eastern side, so it gets the morning sun. I don't fertilise much these days but I do use tropical osmocote when repotting. This plant is not under solarweave so gets rain on it. I feel this is good for the orchids as long as it's not too much.

Dendrobium Graham Hewitt By Patrick Devereux.

This is an Australian Native Hybrid. I am not sure of the correct breeding but I am sure there is Den. speciosum in it. Perhaps Capricornum or Pedunculatum. There is also a possibility Den. kingianum 'alba' is also in it. This plant was acquired from John Dilling and was bred by Troppo John. I grow it where it gets 30% shade in winter and 50% shade in summer under the same conditions as my speciosum's & watered and fertilised the same as all my other orchids. The flowers on this particular plant last for about 3 weeks which is good for an Aust Native. I have not shown this plant for a few years as it has not been out for a meeting or a show. I enjoy growing Aust natives even though they do not flower for very long. As Ted Gregory once said if the Americans had these amazing and showy orchids they would be honored worldwide as a really great orchid.
